- Organize Bootcamps engaging mentors for grooming the innovators to create fundable and solid business models/pitch decks
- Organize the Selection Committee meeting for the approval of the innovations recommended by the Technical Evaluation Panel
- Facilitate the signing of the fund agreements with a2i, innovators, and relevant parties
- Facilitate innovators in creating a work plan and a detailed budget that outlines how the grant funds will be allocated to achieve the grant's objectives
- Facilitate innovators in the successful implementation of the innovation to ensure alignment between grant funds and project objectives
- Conduct due diligence on innovations including market demand assessment and company strengths
- Identify potential sources for funds, such as venture capital, angel investors, crowdfunding, grants, or loans for fundraising for different innovation challenges and the AIF Funded Projects
- Provide technical assistance and expertise to the Awardees, providing relevant knowledge and resources to enhance project success by engaging mentors and experts
