Background of the Project:

The Aspire to Innovate (a2i) Programme builds on the Government of Bangladesh's efforts to introduce a citizen-centric culture of innovation in civil service to improve service delivery and make services more inclusive, affordable, reliable, and easier to access. This project will provide support to establish institutional mechanisms and improve accountability to accelerate SDG achievements in Bangladesh.

This project will have three components:

- 1. Institutionalizing Public Service Innovation and Improving Accountability
- 2. Catalyzing Digital Financial Services and Fintech Innovations
- 3. Incubating Private Sector-enabled Public Service Innovation

Background of the assignment:

The a2i (Aspire to Innovate) Programme, under the Government of Bangladesh, is a flagship initiative focused on transforming public service delivery through innovation, digital technologies, and citizencentric approaches. Established to ensure accessible, inclusive, and efficient public services, a2i strives to enhance governance by fostering a culture of innovation within public institutions and encouraging the use of technology to improve the quality of life for all citizens.

As Bangladesh continues to make strides towards digital transformation, the need for creative solutions to tackle the complex challenges facing government services or industries has never been more critical. The Innovation department of a2i will be at the forefront of this transformation, responsible for driving a vision of public sector modernization and innovative solutions for the industries by leveraging cutting-edge technologies, innovative service delivery models, and new ways of engaging citizens.

'Aspire to Innovate (a2i) Programme' is looking for a Sr. Consultant (a2i Innovation Fund) who will work closely with key government agencies, international partners, universities and other stakeholders to identify opportunities for innovative solutions, encourage knowledge exchange, and help implement pilot projects that have the potential to make a tangible impact on the lives of citizens. This position plays a critical role in positioning Bangladesh as a leader in digital governance in the region and ensuring that innovation is central to the country's development agenda.

Objectives of the assignment:

The overall objective of the assignment will be the following:

- Plan and draft the AIF yearly plan, policies, rules and regulations.
- Lead to ensure the selection of ideas, startups, innovators, and entrepreneurs for fund support.
- Lead to perform due diligence, investment risk and return analysis, and overall fund management activities of the project;

- Develop programs and activities to attract investments from private and public sources for the innovators;
- Collaborate with different committees to advise, evaluate and monitor startups before and after support;
- Lead to mentor, train, groom, incubate and perform investment matchmaking for innovation-funded projects.

Supervision and Performance Evaluation:

The **Sr.** Consultant (a2i Innovation Fund) will be working with the Center of Innovation cluster of the Aspire to Innovate (a2i) Programme. A performance evaluation will be conducted by the project authority of a2i. After the contract period, further continuation of the contract will depend upon the satisfactory performance and availability of funds.

Scope of work, Duties and Responsibilities:

Establish partnerships with at least 5 key stakeholders - government agencies, private sector partners, international organizations, or tech startups - to support innovation initiatives. Implement training and capacity-building programs for government officials and other relevant stakeholders on topics such as innovation management, digital governance, and emerging technologies. Develop and implement a monitoring and evaluation framework to track the impact and progress of innovation projects using data analytics, performance metrics, and citizen feedback. Roll out a set of digital governance tools (e.g. e-participation platforms) aimed at enhancing public service delivery and increasing citizen engagement. Launch citizen-focused innovation initiatives such as digital platforms for public feedback, crowdsourcing ideas for government improvement, or apps for better citizen-government interaction. Compile and submit an annual report on innovation activities that includes key achievements, challenges faced, lessons learned, and recommendations for future innovations within both the public and private sectors.
